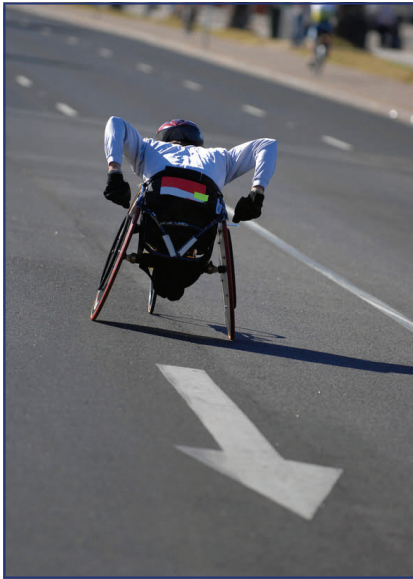




# PARALYMPIC PROGRAMS
